Bus Rules and Regulations:

Seymour Community Schools provides bus transportation for students who reside in areas approved for transportation.

The school bus driver has the same authority as the classroom teacher with regard to directing student's behavior and conduct.

All students are expected to cooperate with the directions of the school bus driver at all times and to abide by the following rules in order to guarantee the safety of every person on the bus.

1. Students shall be waiting at their loading station when the bus arrives.
2. Students shall be seated immediately upon entering the bus. Some students may be assigned specific seats at the driver's direction.
3. Students shall not stand or move from place to place during the trip except by direction of the driver.
4. Students are not to open or close windows or doors except by permission of the driver.
5. Students are not to enter or exit the bus until it has come to a complete stop and the driver has opened the door.
6. Students shall not use loud, boisterous, or profane language.
7. Students shall not tease, scuffle, trip, hold, hit, or use their hands, feet, or body in any objectionable manner.

If a student is reported for violation of any of the above rules, disciplinary action may be taken as stipulated below with parents notified by letter and/or telephone call.

First Offense:	If not a flagrant offense, a warning to the student
Second Offense:	1-day suspension from riding the bus
Third Offense:	3 days suspension from riding the bus
Fourth Offense:	5 days suspension from riding the bus.

****In the event of a flagrant violation of school bus rules and regulations, disciplinary action will be taken with the severity dependent of the seriousness of the infraction.**
